



## RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover

RAIL SAFE can be used to remove graffiti on many different non-porous surfaces including pre-finished metal & powder coated products & has been specially formulated for the public transport sector.

**Note: RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover is NOT recommended for rubber and plastic surfaces. RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover may also be too harsh and printers ink could dissolve.**

### SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When starting a graffiti removal job always wear safety protection before handling any of the graffiti removing products. Safety goggles & chemical resistant gloves are required before using RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover. Wearing long sleeves & long pants are recommended to protect the skin. Always have access to water when working with RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover. If RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover does get on your skin, wash the skin with water to remove the product.

Before using RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover check the surface to see how clean it is. The surface does not have to be perfectly clean to start, but if the surface has substantial dirt on it, the dirt may impede the penetration process & should be washed off before removing the graffiti.

**Note: Always test product on a small hidden area prior to full application.**

## Exterior and Interior Graffiti Removal Process: Equipment Needed for Removal of Graffiti:

1. RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover
2. Safety equipment (goggles, chemical resistant gloves, etc.)
3. Bucket of water
4. White towels

### Application Method:

1. Put your chemical resistant gloves and goggles on
2. Wash down the surface with water using a rag
3. Dab the product liberally on the graffiti
4. Let the product activate on the surface for 60 seconds
5. Agitate surface with wipe
6. Wash off with water using a new rag
7. Repeat steps if graffiti is still showing

At the end of the job, wash down all safety equipment and tools used in the removal process to get all of the RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover off for reuse on the next job.

### Results and Benefits:

The main differences between RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover & other graffiti removal methods include: dramatically reducing the time it takes to remove the graffiti, one application's effectiveness in removing 99% of the typical graffiti & no damage to the original underlying surface! RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover gets all of the graffiti off the surface within minutes while other products can take multiple applications & hours of time. RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover enables removal in minutes on all the typical metal surfaces which saves our customers significant time and labour. RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover is most effective when used in a "wet surface" removal process. By "wet surface process" we are referring to the practice of starting with a water wetted surface and keeping the work surface wet at all times as RAIL SAFE Graffiti Remover is applied, loosens the graffiti and then power washed off with the graffiti.
